

# Star Status & Activity Allowance

Volunteer Teams (VT) are paid an annual activity allowance based on the Star Status level they achieve, and the number of adult members (age 16+) assigned to the group. For example, a team that has Silver Star Status and 258 adult members would receive payment as follows: \$2.50 X 258 members = \$645

## Programs:

**MATCHING GRANT(S):** Fundraiser(s) meant to support Religious Education. Matched .50 on the dollar.

**GRANTS4GOOD (SERVICE):** Up to \$500 for a community service project.

**GRANTS4GOOD (SOCIAL):** PVTs get up to \$500 to support a family or celebratory event.

**GRANTS4GOOD (FAITH):** PVTs get up to \$500 for a faith-based project or initiative.

**MEMBER ASSISTANCE GRANT** Fundraiser to support a member in crisis. Matched dollar for dollar.

**MINISTREE:** Rewarding small acts of service that create a volunteer culture. Credit given to PVT for running program at parish. \$5 a card for online

## Types of Activities:

### Events:

For a social, faith, or service event to count toward Star Status there needs to be proper publicity attached to the Isidore submission. See Publicity Standards.

### Counted once per year:

Funerals/wakes for members  
Masses said for members  
Leading or saying rosary as a group  
Gifts for life milestones

### Newsletters:

Sending a newsletter or other form of communication to members or parishioners can receive one Star Status credit for doing so.

### Donations:

Donations to any two organizations will count towards star status.
